Dear Valued Customer;

Greetings from cold and snowy Northern Indiana!

Hopefully, your 2007 is off to a great start and that you live in a warmer climate than we are experiencing here.

Back in December 2006, the resin suppliers announced two price increases, the first of which was initially slated for January 1, 2007 and the second has been pushed back. On February 1 of this year, we took the first increase in resin costs which appears to have "stuck." For this reason we are announcing an increase in our prices for all can liner products.

As a result of this increase, Rollpak will raise the price of all products by 9% effective on orders placed after March 30, 2007.

This increase seems to be driven largely by foreign PE demand, more particularly, demand from Asia and to a lesser degree by domestic demand. Thus, large quantities of resin are being exported from American ports to meet the foreign demand.

Today's notice allows four weeks prior to implementation. As in the past, we will not accept order loading, nor can we accept orders for delivery beyond normal lead times. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.
